## Essential requirements for the articles:

The structure and content of the article should correspond to the topic of the conference, modern requirements and contain the following necessary elements:

- 1. The problem statement and its connection with the research and practical goals.
- 2. Analysis of recent research and publications, initiating possible solutions to the problem the author is concerned about; The unsolved aspects relating to the issue under analysis of the article should be outlined.
- 3. Research goals.
- 4. Introduction with the full rationale for received research findings.
- 5. Conclusions and perspectives for further research in a chosen field of study.
- 6. References in alphabetical order. Citations and quotations are given in accordance with the current State Standard.
- 7. Article volume may range from 5 to 12 pages.

## Formatting:

- 1. The upper right corner of the page should contain the author's name and surname, job and position (fully without abbreviations). The title is given in capital letters, in bold, and in the middle of the page. References should be placed in the end. Summary and the key words in Ukrainian are given single spaced. Summary and the key words in English are given after references.
- 2. In-text citations are given in parentheses after a quotation or paraphrase. In-text citations should necessarily contain the page number(s).
- 3. The contents (reliability of facts, quotations, proper names, etc.) are solely the responsibility of the authors.
- 4. References are given single spaced after the article.
- 5. Conference materials are published in the author's version, so we are asking thoroughly to edit the articles beforehand in accordance with the modern terminology and spelling.
- 6. Texts of articles should be submitted in Times New Roman, size 14, single-line spacing.
